PRODUCTION TIPS

AC Mustang is much like Sundre barley in that it prefers a moderate well balanced fertilizer package. Too much nitrogen and you will have delayed maturity and lodging.

A high seeding rate, up to 4 bushels per acre, is recommended as it has a large kernel. I've won many seed shows with this oat using a higher seeding rate.

Also, if using this oat for greenfeed, cut soon after heading and certainly well before the dough stage. AC Mustang has unique lignin build in the stem as it matures and can be quite stemmy by the dough stage. This was the technology of the 1980's, to give better lodging resistance.

It is photo-sensitive and loves long days. Seeding early: late April, early May, ensures the plant is mature enough in late June to benefit from this.
